**Camping will be limited and everyone will initially be put on a waiting list, so don't panic that you haven't got a camping spot straight away. Confirmation will be sent by email when/if you get a pitch, before the closing date for entries.**

We endeavour to site helping groups/individuals nearest the rings or their preferred spot but this cannot be guaranteed if not all in the group are helping.

If you are not camping and wish to help at the show please complete a "Helpers Form" and send with your entries.

A ring party (maximum 10) will receive a DINAS tee shirt & lunch pack and will be invited to the famous Dogs In Need breakfast PLUS entry to the "Helpers Prize Draw" on the day they help.

All early helpers will be notified by a committee member prior to the show.

**Arrival Times: Camping units will only be received between 9.00am and 5.00pm no exceptions. Please do not bring waste onto our site from previous shows, dispose of it before you arrive.**

**This schedule provides all the information you need to make the most of your week's holiday with your dogs. It also includes all the rules and guidelines covering the week, which must be strictly adhered to so to make the most of a good time we suggest you read through it.**

**Security: ID bracelets will be issued on arrival Which Must Be Worn All Week  
Vehicle & Camping passes will be issued on arrival. These Must Be Displayed All Week**

These are for your safety and security. Replacement bands will be available from the Secretary.

If you've got DOGS or CHILDREN then this bit's for you – which means it's for everybody.

Rule 46: People or dogs acting in an unreasonable/irresponsible manner will be removed from the show and forfeit all fees paid. All under 18's must be accompanied by an adult who will be held responsible for their conduct for the duration of the show.

No more than 2 dogs per handler off lead in the showground exercise area. PLEASE CLEAR UP after your dogs and place in the bins provided **on the showground**. If you knowingly don't, we will tell you to leave - it's as simple as that. So BAG IT & BIN IT!! The Woods & Common are CLEAR UP areas please **BAG IT & BIN IT** in the bins provided **on the showground**.

Please don't bring training equipment with you because we will not let you use it and you'll have carted all that weight around with you for nothing. Much better to use the space for another couple of bottles.

If you have children with you then they are your responsibility, and are assumed to be under your supervision at all times. Yes – even if they're 6ft tall and tower over you! This means you always know where they are and what they are doing. And if what they are doing is anti-social then we may ask you to leave. We may sympathise, but we don't condone. Parents, please advise your children on safety measures on site, with particular emphasis on road safety and bikes.

Remember the 5mph speed limit doesn't just refer to 4 wheels but 2 wheels as well (and anything else you can find to move about on)

**This is a working showground (not a bowling green) consequently the ground cannot be guaranteed to be totally flat, there are dips and hollows, some maybe created by your own dogs. Please be careful and observant. If you see uneven ground that could be a hazard either bring it to the attention of the show manager or avail yourself of the pile of earth adjacent to ring 4 under the trees, which is there for the purpose of filling holes.**

**For some of the activities at this show we may require you to sign a disclaimer. If you are unable to do this then we are sorry but you will not be able to participate.**

**There will not be any measuring at the Show.**

**There will be rubber coated contacts at this show.**

And of course - THE RULES - you do of course read them avidly on every schedule you receive, but could we ask you to read **Rules 34** onwards again, just to make sure. These are particularly pertinent to the Dogs in Need show. All of the pages in this schedule relate to Rules and Regulations and must be adhered to. So this is a rule to read the Rules!

Due to restrictions placed on us by the local council there will be a reduced PA area, but for all your information and announcements Radio Dogs In Need will be broadcasting again this year, wavelength will be near to last years 86.6 FM and will be confirmed with your running orders. This will be during show hours for general announcements and 24 hours a day for emergencies.

Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licenced event should take all reasonable steps to ensure that the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not put a dogs health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the Board for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations

**Warning: Your dog is vulnerable and AT RISK if left in a vehicle in high temperatures and even on days considered as slightly warm. Please take care of your dog. If your dog is found to be at risk, forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused.**

**Dogs In Need is a Private event only open to Competitors & guests at DINAS discretion.  
It is not open to the general public.**

## WHAT CAN I ENTER?

### YOUR DOG MAY ENTER ANY 3 INDIVIDUAL CLASSES PER DAY FOR WHICH YOUR DOG IS ELIGIBLE PLUS ANY ELIGIBLE HELPING HANDS & YKC CLASSES

That's basically it. Your dog can only enter a **YKC** class providing the handler is a member of the YKC (See page 13 for rules). Your dog can only enter **Helping Hands** if the handler does not run in any other class all week but helps at the show. Please note, the **Junior Classic** classes are included within the three-run limit, they are NOT extra classes.

## WHAT CAN'T I ENTER?

Just as easy -

### **NOT MORE THAN 3 INDIVIDUAL CLASSES PER DAY FOR WHICH YOUR DOG IS ELIGIBLE!** **(with the exception of the above exceptions!)**

Now **everyone** has the same number of runs - how's that for fairness? As usual a dog may only be eligible for, and therefore gain points towards, one **Classic Final** - although they could enter classes for different **Classic** heats (e.g. an ABC jumping and a Graded Jumping) - so you must tell us which Classic you want to earn points for. Full Classic rules can be found on page 6.

## WHAT DO I GET IF I'M BRILLIANT?

For details of awards in Agility Club Starters Challenge Small, Medium, Intermediate & Large see page 12 and Camddwr Novice Cup see page 15. Also see Any Size on page 12, with the exception of these we will be awarding:-

**Trophies** to 1<sup>st</sup> place in all classes, to second place if entries reach more than 30 and 3<sup>rd</sup> place for more than 50.  
**Rosettes** to 10% in all classes. Clear Round Rosettes in all standard classes which must be collected at the ring as soon as you have got the necessary clear round. (Please also see rule 50)

And the really clever clogs get the chance to compete in: **THE WEEK'S FINALS**, where you can win:

Trophies 1st for all Grades/Finals – 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> where average entry of 4 heats is more than 30 and 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> where average entry of 4 heats is more than 50.  
Rosettes: 1st – 3rd + Finalists Rosettes

## HOW DO I ENTER

You will need: Entry form(s); Camping and Helpers Form; Declaration for under 18's

Complete an **Entry Form** for your competing dog(s). Please list classes in numerical order. Make sure you let us know which Classic you are competing for, especially if you have entered more than one type (say Grade 1-2 Jumping and ABC Jumping), if you don't we may have to assume which one. Make sure you list any Not For Competition dogs, They must be 4 months old or over, and registered or Name Applied For with the KC.

If you are entering a **Championship Class** then you also need to list your dogs qualifications for this class. Your name will appear in the Championship Catalogue.

**Please** check the class restrictions carefully – we can't refund if you enter too many.

If your dog is only entering the Helping Hands invitation class you still need to complete an Entry Form so that they get a ring number, otherwise they will be assumed not to be entered for competition. Simply write "Helping Hands Only" in the area provided for listing classes.

Complete a **Camping Form**, if applicable and a **Helpers Form (PLEASE) even if you're not camping** and an under 18's declaration form if applicable. Remember to tell us who you want to camp with and remember to tell the rest of your camping group to use the same name, (if John Brown says he wants to camp with Joe Bloggs, and Joe Bloggs says he wants to camp with John Brown they will probably both end up very lonely). Please nominate a main contact for your group in case of query. Indicate accordingly if you require electric hook up. Remember, it is your responsibility to provide a cable that is long enough to plug into the supply (minimum 25 mtrs). **IT WILL REQUIRE A BLUE 3 PIN MALE CEE PLUG (CARAVAN TYPE) ON THE END.** Electric hook-up can only be supplied if pre-paid, and is 240v 16 amp rate maximum supply only. All entries, camping & electric applications must be made on the appropriate official entry forms and paid in full by close of entries. Camping pitches are approximately 10m x 6m. If your unit plus any ATTACHED awning is over 10m in length remember to specify the length on the Camping Form in the box provided. If you pitch any other unit within your pitch area (eg tent, etc) there must be a minimum 3m gap left between units. These are fire regulations and **MUST BE ADHERED TO.** Any units not complying will be asked to move, so for your own sake please ensure you book enough pitches to accommodate your set-up. We cannot guarantee where any overflow camping will be sited. **Camping numbers are limited.** **IF YOU DO NOT WANT YOUR ENTRY PROCESSING IF CAMPING IS FULL THEN YOU MUST TICK THE BOX ON THE CAMPING FORM.** Rules 43, 49, 52 and 53 also particularly apply, so to avoid any confusion here they are again:

44. For the safety of dogs/people it is the responsibility of those using electric hook-ups and/or generators to provide adequate protection for cables and their own lead. People camping in groups who require electric will be sited nearest to the electric supply points.
50. No camping units allowed on the Show ground before 9.00am Monday 15<sup>th</sup> August 2022. Early show helpers will be notified by a committee member and must book in on arrival. Camping numbers are limited. The Show ground will be locked from 24.00hrs - 07.00 hrs each night. Camping units will be received Monday 15<sup>th</sup> – Saturday 20<sup>th</sup> between the hours of 9.00am – 5.00pm only.
53. All fees must be paid in pounds sterling and drawn on a UK bank or postal order. All entries, camping & electric must be made on the appropriate official entry forms and **paid in full** by close of entries. Camping pitches and electric hook-ups are **NOT TRANSFERABLE** and may not be purchased after close of entries. Anyone found accessing camping and or electric hook-up without the appropriate site pass will be removed from the showground.
54. All camping roadways on site must be kept clear at all times. The erection of training equipment is forbidden.

### **Read Page 2 again**

Put all your forms in a C5 (A5) envelope, so you do the minimum amount of folding, we do the minimum amount of unravelling, and you pay normal postage. **REMEMBER – IF YOU USE A LARGE A4 ENVELOPE, OR FOLD IT ALL UP REALLY SMALL INTO A SMALL BUT FAT ENVELOPE, THEN THE POSTAGE IS HIGHER.** Underpayments not only cost a lot but will hold up your entry as we have to go and collect it. **Make sure you put the correct address on...And finally-**

**PLEASE DON'T STAPLE!!!**

**FINAL FINAL CHECK!!!**

**JUNIORS** - are you eligible? Check the junior classifications carefully – Saturday's junior may be Tuesday's adult.

Finally, please make sure you list all your NFC dogs you're bringing for a holiday - we'd hate to send them away with a stick attached to a tied spotty bag over their shoulder!

### **AND IF IT'S STILL WRONG?...**

Because of the volume of entries, we may make the following assumptions concerning incorrect entries:

**INCORRECT FEES:** under payment and we will chase you for the loot! Over payment, thank you very much for your generous contribution. (well, it is for charity!). Bounced cheque or fees remaining underpaid? We will return your entry.....

**INCORRECT CLASS ENTRIES:** for dogs entered in more than the allowed classes, we will remove them from the highest grade non-special agility class, followed by the highest grade non-special jumping class. Championship classes will not be cancelled.

**Juniors** entered as an addition to a dog's three entries will be removed from the junior entry. If your entry is sent in early enough when we're still in bouncy mood, we'll ring you first to check, but as closing date approaches – beware!

# THE DINAS CLASSICS

## PLEASE READ THE RULES CAREFULLY!

- 1 The **DINAS Classics** will be in thirty two categories. Each Classic will have four qualifying classes, 2 agility and 2 jumping, for which points may be gained to qualify towards the Invitation Final.
- 2 **Dogs** may enter a maximum of any **two** Classic classes per day for which they are eligible, but may only qualify for one Final. If no Final has been nominated, and it is not clear which Final applies, then the Final may be assumed by us.
- 3 Points will be awarded according to any place achieved in each class of the nominated or assumed Classic, as per the official prize-giving for that class. 1st place will receive 50 points, 2nd place 49 points, etc. down to the last place awarded.
- 4 The main handler on the entry form will be the handler listed in the posted league tables, and will be the handler invited to compete in the Finals. If a change of handler is required, the main handler must notify Agility Aid in writing as soon as possible after the qualifiers have been declared but no later than 9.00am on the morning of the event.
- 5 A full listing of dog/handler combinations achieving points will be displayed at the Show after the first 2 heats and again after the 4 heats. Those appearing in the final listing up to and including the designated lowest place will be invited to take part in the Finals on Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> or Sunday 21<sup>st</sup> August 2022.
- 6 Invited finalists **MUST** book in the morning of their Classic at Ring 1's score tent by the designated time or they will not be allowed to run. Booking in for **Finalists** is achieved by completing a commentary card (supplied in the score tent) and handing it in.
- 7 A list of invited Finalists will be displayed at the Show the evening of the last Classic heats for that Classic.
- 8 The number to qualify in each final will be decided on completion of the four qualifying classes, and will be displayed at the Show.
- 9 The dog/handler running order for each final will be displayed at the ring and will be strictly adhered to.
- 10 There will be **NO** reserves called for the final.

## ELIGIBILITY FOR CLASSES

In the following definitions of classes First Prizes or other prize wins are those gained in standard classes at any Kennel Club licenced Championship Agility, Premier Agility, Open Agility or Limited Agility shows (i.e. special classes and invitational events excepted).

Standard classes may be scheduled for Agility Shows, as Agility classes or Jumping Classes. All standard classes must contain the Weaving Poles obstacle. Standard Agility classes must contain the following elements: A Ramp, Dog Walk and See-Saw. With this proviso classes are defined as follows:-

A maximum of four standard classes may be scheduled for any dog on an individual day of competition. Any number of special classes may be scheduled.

**Class Structure.** A class may either be held as a Graded Class or a Combined Class. A Graded class may be scheduled for a maximum of three consecutive Grades with separate results and awards issued for each grade. A combined Class may be scheduled for more than one consecutive grade with one overall set of results.

**Progression.** Progression from each Grade will be determined by the eligibility for the class as referenced in H(1)(A)11. Results from Combined Classes will only count towards progression from the dog's current grade.

To count for progression wins must be gained in standard classes at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows.

Only a first place with a clear round completed within the course time set by the judge will count towards grade progression.

Competitors will be allowed to walk the course set at Small, Medium, Intermediate or Large height without their dog(s) before the class begins.

**Points Progression.** At the handlers discretion the dog may progress up to Grade 4 by winning 100 points at each grade, using the Agility Warrant points scheme (Regulation K3.d refers). A minimum of 50 points must be gained in agility (not jumping) classes in the relevant grade. except that there is no requirement for a minimum number of agility points. If this method of progression is selected, the handler must ensure the Show Secretary signs the dog's Agility Record Book at the first show entered at the higher grade. There is no time limit on this progression, however once a dog has progressed, it cannot return to a previous grade.

Progression on points must be done prior to closing date of entries. It is not possible to change a grade on points once the entries have closed.

### STANDARD CLASSES.

Only first prizes and points gained in standard classes at Kennel Club licenced Agility Shows may be used for progression through the classes. (A dog is only eligible for one grade). In defining the eligibility of the owner or handler for Grade 1, the two wins and points progression referred to in the definition apply only to one dog and not an accumulation of dogs.

**Grade 1** Open to owners, handlers or dogs which have not gained a minimum of two first places at Grade 1 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows, at least one of which must have been gained in an agility (not jumping) class. N.B. Owners, handlers or dogs previously qualified out of Grade 1 are not eligible for this class.

**Grade 2** Open to dogs which are not eligible for Grade 1 or have elected to progress on points from Grade 1 and are not eligible for Grades 3, 4, 5, 6 or 7.

**Grade 3** Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of two first places at Grade 2 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows, one of which must have been gained in an agility (not jumping) class, or have elected to progress on points from Grade 2 and are not eligible for Grades 2, 4, 5, 6 or 7.

**Grade 4** Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of three first places at Grade 3 at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows, two of which must have been gained in agility (not jumping) classes, or have elected to progress on points from Grade 3 and are not eligible for Grades 2,3, 5, 6 or 7.

**Grade 5** Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of four first places at Grade 4 at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows, two of which must have been gained in an agility (not jumping) classes, and are not eligible for Grades 2,3, 4, 6 or 7.

**Grade 6** Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of four first places at Grade 5 at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows, two of which must have been gained at Agility (not Jumping) Classes, and are not eligible for Grades 2, 3, 4, 5 or 7.

**Grade 7** Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of five first places at Grade 6 at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows, three of which must have been gained in agility (not jumping) classes, and are not eligible for Grades 2, 3, 4, 5 or 6.

**Championship Class** Open to dogs having qualified to compete in Grade 7 which have had five wins at Full Height in either Grade 6 or Grade 7, at least three of which must be gained in agility classes. To consist of 2 qualifying rounds of Standard Kennel Club Classes, 1 Agility Class and 1 Jumping Class and a final round of Agility to be held at the same Show.

## SPECIAL CLASSES

Societies may schedule classes other than those defined above as “special classes”. The eligibility for “special” classes must be defined by the society and included in the schedule. The word “special” must be included in the title of the class. Where special classes are classified for older and/or inexperienced dogs, the height of the hurdles, the A-ramp, and the dog walk, and the length of the long jump, may be reduced below the dimensions specified in these regulations, in which case such dimensions must be included in the class definition in the show schedule.

Marking for special classes may deviate from marking for standard classes, but must be specified in the schedule. Wins, places and clear rounds in special classes will not count towards agility warrant points or grade progression at Kennel Club shows.

**JUNIOR UNDER 12 YRS:** Open to handlers under 12 years of age as at 16<sup>th</sup> August 2022

**JUNIOR 12-15 YRS:** Open to handlers aged 12 or over but under 16 years of age as at 16<sup>th</sup> August 2022

**YKC JUNIOR 6 – UNDER 12 YRS:** Open to handlers 6 years and up to but not including 12<sup>th</sup> birthday

**YKC JUNIOR 12 – UNDER 18 YRS:** Open to handlers 12 years and up to but not including 18<sup>th</sup> birthday

**ABC:** This class is open to all Large and Intermediate dogs excluding Border Collies, Working Sheepdogs and their crosses. (Any breeds but collies). In the event of a dispute the judges decision will be final.

**ANY SIZE:** These classes are for dogs not entered in any other class at this show except Any Size. They are fun classes aimed at those dogs either nearing retirement but still fit or just setting out on their agility career. There will be no Weaving Poles, Tyre or Long Jump. Jump heights will be 40cm, 30cm & 20cm and you may run your dog at whichever height you wish regardless of their size. The course will be simple and free flowing with a maximum of 18 obstacles. There will be no place rosettes or trophies but special clear round rosettes will be awarded.

**Overseas visitors please note, you MUST have your ATC number from the British Kennel Club BEFORE you can enter the show, and this number MUST be on your entry form.**

**A dog may only compete at the height and grade for which they are eligible.**

In accordance with Kennel Club Regulation H(1)(B)4, all newly competing small, medium and intermediate dogs must have been officially measured before competing at this show. Record books must be available for viewing at this show if requested.

**NB: There will be no measuring at this show**

### THE AGILITY CLUB LARGE, INTERMEDIATE, MEDIUM & SMALL STARTERS CHALLENGE HEATS RULES

- 1 The competition will be run under the relevant Kennel Club Regulations in force at the time. Handlers will be deemed to have agreed to abide by these rules and regulations. Dogs will compete at their measured height. **The class will run as a Graded 1 & 2 Agility Class**
- 2 Each Heat is open to all Grade 1-2 dogs of the correct size for each heat, each heat will offer awards for the heights on offer as follows; Rosettes to a minimum of 10%. Trophies: Entries less than 30 = 1<sup>st</sup>, Entries 30-60 = 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup>, Entries over 60 = 1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup>.
- 3 **ONLY** Dogs handled by an Agility Club member at the time of competing (**date of joining/renewal must be prior to the first day of the show**) may qualify for the Final. In order to compete in the Final you must also be a current member of The Agility Club on the day of the final.
- 4 The competition will normally consist of up to twenty Heats. The **highest placed** Agility Club member in each Grade at the Heat will go through to the Final, providing they have achieved an awarded place as detailed in paragraph 2.
- 5 Both handler and dog may only qualify once for each height Final. Each handler & dog pairing may only qualify once for the final. In the event of the highest placed dog(s) having qualified previously, the next highest placed dog will qualify. *The Agility Club reserves the right to call on the next placed Agility Club member if the highest placed is unable to attend the final.*

**Helping Hands** – This class will be a Free of Charge invitation jumping event on Saturday, for all sizes and all grades (so borrow a good un). Handlers must not have run a dog in any other class during the week and, of course, must have helped at the show during the week. This class is for those noble helpers who do the work without running a dog. If it was just for anyone who helps then it would have about 2000 dogs in it! (We hope!). For your invitation to run see the Show Manager or Show Secretary. Maximum 2 dogs per handler. See also page 5 “Helping Hands Only” entries.

## **The Kennel Club Large Dog Agility Stakes**

This competition will be classified as combined Grades 5-7 and judged under the Kennel Club Regulations for standard classes.

Competitors may enter more than one dog in a heat. Competitors may qualify more than one dog for the quarter-finals. However, only the competitor's highest placed dog at the quarter-finals will qualify for the semi-final.

Once a dog has qualified for the quarter-final, further heats may be entered for competition although any placings in these further heats will not affect the dog's eligibility for the quarter-finals/semi-finals.

The first five previously unqualified placed dogs from each heat will go forward to the quarter-finals. If the heat is split then three dogs will be taken from each part. The first 20 dogs from this quarter-final will qualify for the semi-final held at The London International Horse Show.

The 20 dogs who qualify for The Kennel Club large dog Agility Stakes will compete in the semi-final held at The London International Horse Show. The top ten highest-placed dogs in the semi-final will qualify for the evening grand final held at The London International Horse Show (subject to the above).

Those dogs eligible to compete in competition for large dogs are those measuring over 500mm at the withers.

## **The Kennel Club Large Dog ABC Agility Stakes**

This competition will be classified as combined grades 5-7 and judged under the Kennel Club regulations for standard classes.

This competition is a special agility competition open to all dogs excluding Border Collies, Working Sheepdogs, and any of their crosses. Any concerns should be recorded in the incident book and reported to The Kennel Club.

Those dogs eligible to compete in competition for large dogs are those measuring over 500mm at the withers.

Competitors may enter more than one dog in a heat. Competitors may qualify more than one dog for the semi-final, however only the competitor's highest placed dog at the semi-Final will qualify for the grand final. Once a dog has qualified for the semi-final/final, further heats may be entered for competition although any placings in these further heats will not affect the dog's eligibility for the semi-final/final.

The first three previously unqualified placed dogs from each heat will go forward to the semi-final. The first ten dogs from this semi-final will qualify for the final held at The London International Horse Show (subject to the above).

A maximum of two representatives of any one breed may be invited to the final from the semi-final. This decision will be at the organiser's discretion.

## **Crufts Novice Cup Dog Agility Stakes 2023/2024**

All events must be judged under the appropriate Kennel Club regulations H & H (1) in force at the time of the event. Competitors entering any competition will be deemed to have agreed to abide by these regulations.

Dogs should be eligible to enter a Grade 3, 4 or 5 class at the time of qualifying for the semi-final. Any subsequent wins gained by the dog will not alter its eligibility to compete in the Semi-Final or Final.

There will be up to 14 separate heats for large, intermediate, medium and small height dogs at Kennel Club licensed shows throughout the country, plus an additional heat at the International Agility Festival.

Competitors may enter more than one dog in a heat. Competitors may qualify more than one dog for the Semi-Final at the International Agility Festival, however only the competitor's highest placed dog at the Semi-Final will qualify for the Crufts Grand Final.

Once a dog has qualified for the Semi-Final, further heats may be entered for competition although any placings in these heats will not affect the dog's eligibility for the Semi-Final.

## **Crufts Novice Cup Rules Cont.....**

### **Qualifying**

The first 2 previously unqualified dogs from each heat will go forward to the Semi-Final at the Kennel Club International Agility Festival. There will also be a Novice Cup heat at the Kennel Club International Agility Festival, where the first 5 previously unqualified placed dogs will also go forward to Saturday's Semi-Final. If the heat is split then 2 dogs will be taken from each part.

If a competitor does not take up the invitation to compete in the semi-final, the invitation will be rolled down to the next applicable dog from the relevant heat.

The top 6 large dogs, 6 intermediate, 6 medium dogs and 6 small dogs from the Semi-Final round of the Kennel Club Novice Cup will be invited to compete in the Final at Crufts 2024.

### **YKC Agility Dog of the Year Crufts 2023 (ADOY)**

The competition is open to YKC members only, aged 6 years and up to, but not including 18th birthday handling any Kennel Club registered dog. There are eight classes divided by age of member and size of dog as listed below:

- 06-11 Years with large/intermediate/medium/small dogs
- 12-17 Years with large/intermediate/medium/small dogs

Please enter the class age category you will be on the day of the qualifier.

•The YKC method for Crufts qualification is a points based system as follows:

1<sup>st</sup> Place = 30 points / 2<sup>nd</sup> Place = 15 points / 3<sup>rd</sup> Place = 10 points

Points are gained per handler/dog combination. If the same handler gains points with another dog in ADOY- these points will be separate. 30 or more points during the year in ADOY competitions guarantees qualification to the ADOY semi-final at next year's Crufts.

•Please note: you may only compete with one dog in the Crufts ADOY Semi Final. Should you manage to qualify more than one dog, you must choose one, the other qualified dogs may be used as a reserve should your first choice be unavailable.

•Members must ensure that their fees to the Young Kennel Club (YKC) are up to date and fully paid in order to enter any Young Kennel Club class.

•These schedule rules must be read in conjunction with the most up to date YKC Agility Rules found on the YKC website ([www.ykc.org.uk](http://www.ykc.org.uk)).

## **The Camddwr Cup 2022**

A points based series sponsored by Camddwr Canine Ltd and RAS Rosettes

The Camddwr Cup will be run throughout the agility season and will culminate in awards for points gained at various heats throughout the year.

The Camddwr Cup will be open to all heights of dog. There will be 6 heats for each height category. Small, Medium, Intermediate & Large.

Each heat will be open to dogs competing in grades 3 - 5  
All heats will be awarded points for the following places:

1st place 5 points, 2nd place 4 points, 3rd place 3 points, 4th place 2 points & 5th place 1 point.

Placings and points for the points series will only be awarded for clean runs within the course time  
Clubs hosting heats will provide results for the organiser of the Camddwr Cup which will be maintained on our website [www.camddwrcanine.co.uk](http://www.camddwrcanine.co.uk) and our Facebook page The Camddwr Cup.

All heats will be identified as qualifiers and will be sponsored by Camddwr Canine Ltd and RAS rosettes.  
Handlers may run as many dogs as they wish in the heats and but points will only be accumulated and allocated to the same handler and dog combinations.

### **Prizes**

Camddwr Canine Ltd and co-sponsor RAS rosettes will supply the following prizes for each heat  
Rosettes to 10 percent of entries and a trophy/prize for the winner.

All heats are run under kennel club regulation H at licensed events and will be run as standard classes.

A competitor not wishing to take part in the points series is obliged to inform us of their request to withdraw- at which point their details will be removed. All participants in the series will provide assumed consent to the results and any relating pictures and press releases being used for promotional and associated media purposes relating to the event by camddwr canine Ltd and its partners.

### **Points series**

The points series will close 10 days after the final heat and a date will then be announced as to when the winners of each height category will be announced.

### **The overall winner of the Camddwr Cup 2022**

The overall winner will be the handler and dog combination with the most points gained from the points series over all heights.

In the event of a tie, the combination with the most wins will be considered the overall winner.

Times may be used in the event of a tie breaker should competitors tie for the overall winning place.

### **Prizes**

The points series winners for each height will receive product prizes and a trophy/rosette

The overall winner of the converted Camddwr Cup will be awarded the silver perpetual trophy winners sash plus coveted product prizes.



## SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1 Dogs entered at Kennel Club Licensed Agility shows must be registered at the Kennel Club in accordance with Kennel Club Regulations for Classification and Registration B, or else registration or transfer of registration must have been applied for. The registration number/authority to compete number will be required for each entry.
- 2 All dogs registered and resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete (ATC) number before entry to the show can be made. All overseas entries without a Kennel Club Registration number or an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
- 3 Entry fees: £4.20 per dog per class, £15.00 per Championship entry. Camping £100.00, electric hook-up £55.00. Postage £2.00. All entries, camping and electric are inclusive of VAT at the standard rate. If you require a VAT receipt please send an SAE marked 'VAT' with your entries.
- 4 No prize money will be paid.
- 5 Internet entries will be accepted via [www.agilityshows.online](http://www.agilityshows.online)
- 6 The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
- 7 Only dogs of 18 calendar months of age and over on the day of competition are eligible for competition at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows.
- 8 A dog must not compete in the same class more than once, including special classes.
- 9 Not for competition entries will be accepted for dogs aged four calendar months and over. Dogs must be Kennel Club Registered with their details recorded on the entry form.
- 10 No bitch in season is allowed to compete.
- 11 The mating of bitches within the precincts of the competition is forbidden.
- 12 No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time within the boundaries of the show.
- 13 Dogs must not wear any type of slip, half-slip collar or lead when under test. A single flat, close fitting, leather or webbing collar is permitted, providing the only attachment is a plain identification panel as an integral part of the collar i.e. not attached by a ring.
- 14 Should a Judge be unable to fulfil the appointment to judge, the committee reserves the right to appoint another Judge.
- 15 No competitor shall impugn the decision of the Judge or Judges.
- 16 Sponsors are listed in the schedule.
- 17 Kennel Club standard marking regulations will apply for all standard classes.
- 18 Jump heights for Anysize will be 20cm, 30cm & 40cm (see page 12)
- 19 Height limit for dogs:
  - a. Large Dog Classes - For dogs measuring over 500mm at the withers.
  - b. Intermediate Dog Classes - For dogs measuring over 430mm and measuring 500mm or under at the withers.
  - c. Medium Dog Classes - For dogs measuring over 350mm and measuring 430mm or under at the withers.
  - d. Small Dog Classes - For dogs measuring 350mm or under at the withers.
- 20 Judges at an Agility Show may not enter for competition a dog which is recorded in their ownership or part ownership; or handle a dog at the Show at which they are judging. Dogs may be disqualified if proved to have been handled in the class by the scheduled judge's spouse or immediate family, or resident at the same address as the scheduled judge.
- 21 Removal of dogs from Competition:

Following discussion between the show management and/or a veterinary surgeon, a dog shall be prevented from competing and/or removed from the show if it is:-

  1. A bitch which is in season.
  2. Suffering from any infectious diseases or contagious disease.
  3. Interfering with the safety or chance of winning of an opponent.
  4. Of such temperament or is so much out of control as to be a danger to the safety of any person or other animal.
  5. Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues competing.

The circumstances of such removal shall be recorded in the competition/show Incident Book and submitted to the Kennel Club.
- 22 Dog Agility is a competitive and physically strenuous activity. It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to ensure their dog is "fit for function and that they themselves are fit to take part. By signing the entry form you confirm that to the best of your knowledge your dog is fit and able to take part in Agility classes on the day of the show.
- 23 In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including 25 days before the start of the competition, i.e. 22nd July 2022 shall be counted when entering for any class. For these purposes a competition shall be defined as all classes covered within the same schedule. In the event that a dog becomes eligible for the next grade at a particular show, after the entry for that show has been sent, it is the competitors responsibility to notify the show secretary at least 14 days before the date of the show i.e. 2nd August 2022. The dog will then be moved into the appropriate class(s) for the next grade. The dog must be moved into the corresponding number of classes as were entered in the lower grade. If there are fewer or no classes available for the next grade the competitor should be offered a refund of the relevant entry fees.
- 24 Should circumstances so dictate, the Society, in consultation with the judges, may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them must be reported to the Kennel Club.
- 25 In the event that the show is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances, the club/society will refund fees, less any reasonably incurred expenses. If the show processor has the provisions to do so, competitors will be refunded in the manner in which they had entered the show, but in any event, the society will refund fees within three months of the show date to all those that had entered and requested a refund within one month of the show date and on receipt of a stamped addressed envelope.
- 26 Except for mobility aids, nothing shall be carried in the hand while the dog is under test and food shall not be given to the dog whilst in the ring. Competitors are prohibited from wearing bags or leads whilst under test.
- 27 Should a judge deem a re-run is required, any result and/or faults gained in the previous run must be discounted.
- 28 Separate entry forms must be completed by each owner and must be signed by the owner or his authorised agent in accordance with the provisions specified thereon. Entry forms must be accompanied with the appropriate fees.
- 29 Competition of Dogs Suffering from Contagious or Infectious Disease - No dogs suffering from infectious or contagious disease or having been exposed to such disease during the period of 21 days prior to the Competition may compete. Competitors infringing the Regulation will be liable to be fined and/or dealt with under Kennel Club Rule A11.
- 30 It is the competitors responsibility to be available for their class and running order. Competitors must run as close to their running order as possible. Failure to do so may be reported to the Kennel Club. In Championship classes competitors must run in exact running order specified in the

**31 Animals at the Event**

No animal other than one officially entered shall be brought into the precincts of the event during its continuance, except any dogs registered to assist the disabled, or dogs required for educational or instructional purposes, or by permission of the Board.

However, at the discretion of the show society a dog brought to the show by a spectator may be admitted into the precincts of the dog show, with the proviso that those in charge of the dog sign a declaration confirming the dog is free from disease and that the dog will be kept under proper control at all times

32 A pay on the day class will be held if time permits

33 There will not be a practice ring. There will be a Junior Training ring for pre-entered structured training only.

34 Welfare of Dogs An exhibitor (or Competitor) whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licenced event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog is met, and should not knowingly put their dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. A breach of this Regulation may be referred to the Board for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations. The use of pinch collars, electronic shock collars or prong collars, is not permitted at an Agility show licensed by the Kennel Club. This shall apply at the venue and within the precincts of the show.

35 Competitors are reminded of the suffering that can be caused when dogs are left in vehicles on sunny days. Remedial action will be taken in the event of dogs found in a distressed condition

36 All dogs will be entered at this Show at their owner's risk. Whilst the Committee and helpers will undertake every care, they will not take responsibility for loss, damage or injury howsoever caused to dogs, persons or property.

37 There will be no practising/training in the Ring during or after the Show.

38 The Competition Manager cannot enter or work a dog at the Show.

39 Please clear up after your dogs and place in bins provided. Anyone knowingly not doing so will be asked to leave the Venue and forfeit any remaining class entries.

40 Puppies under 4 calendar months of age are not permitted at the Show. This includes the Car Parks and Exercise areas.

41 Please do not leave your dogs loose when unattended, tethers should be a maximum of 2mtrs in length.

42 Speed limit on site is 5mph (KC recommendation) and will be strictly enforced. All drivers of vehicles on site must hold a full driving licence.

43 All caravans/camping units to carry suitable fire extinguishers and facilities for fire fighting and first aid. All vehicles/caravans/camping units must display passes at all times. Any found not doing so will be removed from the Showground. Fire points will be indicated by a solid red flag. Campers are asked not to fly red flags from their caravans.

44 For the safety of dogs/people it is the responsibility of those using electric hook-ups and/or generators to provide adequate protection for cables and their own lead. People camping in groups who require electric will be sited nearest to the electric supply points.

45 All people and dogs attending the Show will be bound by Dogs In Need Rules. All Trade Stand vendors must comply with the Rules and Regulations of this Show. Only those having paid for a trade stand will be allowed to trade at this show, any un-authorized traders will be immediately removed from the showground forfeiting any camping/entry fees.

46 People or dogs acting in an unreasonable/irresponsible manner will be removed from the Show and forfeit all fees paid. All under 18's must be accompanied by an adult who will be held responsible for their conduct for the duration of the Show.

47 Definition of Test Area - all rings.

48 Running orders **MUST** be adhered to (with the exception of bona fide workers or a note from teacher) unless you want to face not running.

49 A dog which is known to be unsociable and 'snappy' must be muzzled when in the vicinity of people or other dogs.

50 No camping units allowed on the Show ground before 9.00am Monday 15th August 2022. Early show helpers will be notified by a committee member and must book in on arrival. Camping numbers are limited. The Show ground will be locked from 24.00hrs - 7.00 hrs each night. Camping units will be received Monday 15th – Saturday 20th between the hours of 9.00am to 5.00pm only.

51 Rosettes and awards must be collected at the Show. Rosettes & awards will not be issued before the official prize-giving.

52 The owner, competitor, handler or any other person in charge of a dog at a Kennel Club licensed event must at all times ensure that the dog is kept under proper control whilst at the licensed venue, including its environs, car & caravan parks & approaches. All dogs must be kept on lead other than when in the test area and the designated exercise area where they must still be under control.

53 All fees must be paid in pounds sterling and drawn on a UK bank or postal order. All entries, camping & electric must be made on the appropriate official entry forms and **paid in full** by close of entries. Camping pitches & electric hook-ups are NOT TRANSFERABLE and may not be purchased after close of entries. Anyone found accessing camping/electric hook up without the appropriate site pass will be removed from the showground.

54 All camping roadways on site must be kept clear at all times. The erection of training equipment is forbidden.

55 Day parkers must park in the day parking area or be removed, and must display their form number at all times. Disabled people with badges will be allowed to park in the disabled parking area.

56 All people at this show have a responsibility to take care of the health and safety of themselves and others, and to report any health and safety concerns to the Show Manager

58 The Committee reserves the right to return any entries, without further notification, if fees remain unpaid, for whatever reason.

59 Digital or analogue recording within the precincts of the show for reward or gain will only be allowed by permission of the Show Manager.

60 Under section 2 of the Health Act 2006, smoking will not be permitted within any covered or enclosed public area, including score tents.

61 Collecting of money is not permitted at this show.

62 The show organisers or their authorised agents may make results from this show publicly available (including but not limited to the names of competitors and their dogs) and share results with third parties for the same purpose.
